## Improving Urban Waters in Dalgety Bay.

### What we are doing

We are upgrading the wastewater system in your area to help manage heavy rainfall, protect your community from flooding and improve the water environment. We will construct a replacement Storm Overflow (SO) to house a powered screen with some local sewer re-alignment work. This work will involve a section of Moray Way South being closed (Phase 1&2) and St Bridgets Brae (Phase 2). (See maps overleaf).

### When are we doing it

Work is planned to start for Phase 1 on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2026. This programme of work is expected to be completed late autumn 2026. Work is planned to start for Phase 2 on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2026 and is expected to be completed approx. 4 months.

### What happens next

- Pedestrian access will be maintained, however there may be footpath diversions in place.
- New temporary access road through Jubilee park to allow local vehicular access to Inchview Gardens, St Bridget's Brae/North and Dalgety Bay Primary School.
- Local bus routes will be affected.
- Diversion route is via Moray Way North. Please follow all signage in place.
- Local access to private driveway's at St Bridget's brae will be maintained utilising the new temporary access road through Jubilee park. Should there be any time where access needs to be restricted our site team will liaise with individual customers directly.
- **There will be no planned disruption to your water or waste services during our work.**
- We will do all we can to keep disruption to a minimum.
