## Taking care of your sewer network in Lincluden

### What we are doing

We are taking care of your waste water services in your community which will help prevent sewer flooding and to do this we need to upgrade the sewer network in your area.

### When are we doing it

**The project to help prevent sewer flooding will start week commencing 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026. The programme of work is expected to be completed within 12 months.**

### What happens next

- Please see over the page for site layout along with pipeline route.
- Your wastewater supply will not be affected by these works.
- The project will consist of installing a new pipeline as well as the construction of a new storm overflow tank.
- The initial phase of work will involve setting up the site compound along with removing some trees and shrubs. There will be no parking available throughout the project at the location of the storm overflow tank.
- To facilitate the new waste water pipeline, we require to divert some existing water pipes.
- **We may need to turn off your water supply. If we do, we will send you further information at least 48 hours in advance, detailing the dates and times that your supply will be affected and what to do.**
- There will be roadworks during the dates above. This will include the use of temporary traffic lights, road closure and footpath closure. Advanced signage will be in place prior to any road closures taking place. Please follow all signs put in place.
- You may see and hear an increase in construction traffic and noise during the project our site team will endeavor to keep the level of noise and disruption to a minimum.
- Working areas will be reinstated to their original condition upon completion of the project.
